World Healthal Trust [Registration. No. 5652/2008] is a tax-exempt non-profit organization registered under the Trust Registration Act, 1860, and is listed on the NITI Aayog Darpan Portal- (DARPAN ID: **DL/2017/0153979**). The motto of the organization is: *Providing Equity in Healthcare & Education*, for it strives to make available the essentials of good health and education to those who need them most.

World Healthal Trust is recognized by the Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR) for its contributions to public health research and education, further strengthening the technical credibility of its programs. WHT holds CSR-1 registration and works with a commitment to improving preventive healthcare awareness, strengthening educational environments, and supporting community-led development. The Trust began with focused health literacy initiatives in Delhi–NCR, where it conducted workshops, school-based awareness programs, and early cancer screening campaigns. These early interventions laid the foundation for a structured model of community outreach that combined scientific knowledge with grassroots engagement.

Over the years, WHT expanded its operations into multiple districts of Uttar Pradesh, with a strong presence in Gautam Buddha Nagar, where it has built enduring partnerships with government schools, panchayats, health institutions, and the local community. Since inception, WHT has successfully implemented numerous field projects in areas such as early cancer screening and HPV vaccination awareness, geriatric wellness, adolescent health education, community hygiene promotion, and school learning-environment improvement. The initiatives include multi-village cancer screening camps supported by government bodies such as Vigyan Prasara (VP) – Department of Science Technology, Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR),

Directorate of Health Services (DHS) Government NCT of Delhi and PSUs such as National Small Industries Corporation. The Trust's projects also include school-based programs and infrastructure enhancement support for government schools. Each project has been executed with a structured approach to planning, documentation, stakeholder participation, and measurable impact reporting.

The most recent initiative of WHT includes promotion of Integrative Healthcare, combining the best of modern medicine with traditional systems of healing in consonance with the mandate of Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India.

The organization's work is supported by a team of public health professionals, scientists, doctors, educationists, project managers, and community mobilizers who ensure that interventions are evidence-based and aligned to the needs of underserved populations. Emphasis on transparency, financial discipline, and technical quality has established WHT as a dependable implementation partner for Government bodies, Corporates, PSUs besides other private and public institutions.

Over the years, we have reached out to 120,000+ individuals through cancer awareness campaigns on early signs, risks and prevention of common cancers, screened 5,000+ people for preventable cancers with follow-up care, engaged 1,000+ senior citizens through continuous elderly-care workshops, and involved 50,000+ participants in programs related to biosafety & biosecurity, GMP/GLP, adolescent health, propagation of medicinal plants, and issues concerning mental health.
